



INSURANCE

Prior to participating in an ERNA organised game of netball (including Day and Night competitions, Gala Day and Carnivals), all players must be registered members of Netball NSW.

All players and non-players registered with NNSW are covered by insurance. To guarantee all your Club Coaches, Managers, Umpires, Officials, Administrative staff, Voluntary Workers etc. are covered by insurance they must either be registered as players or non-players with ERNA.

INSURANCE CLAIMS

The Netball Australia Insurance for 2025 is provided by Howden. Should an injury occur at the netball courts, contact the Ground Supervisor (Brush Farm) or the Physiotherapist at Meadowbank Park who will write the particulars in the Injury Book.

Before submitting the claim form, the declaration on page 4 must be completed by either a relevant Club Official or the Association Secretary. Pre-Existing Conditions

If a player has a pre-existing medical condition, then that player is required to supply the Eastwood Ryde Netball Association with a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner, stating that the existing medical condition will not constitute a health risk to either the player concerned or any other person whether now or in the future.

Should players / umpires require strapping there is no charge if they bring their own tape. A charge of \$4 will be made to strap a large area of the body. Rolls of tape can be purchased from the Canteen for \$7.
